Rowland Onuegbu, SDV, priest of the Society of Divine Vocations (SDV) and a native of Imo State, Nigeria, will visit our parish and speak at all our Masses next weekend. He will share with us the Missionary work of his congregation. The mission of the Society of Divine Vocations, more commonly referred to as the "Vocationist Fathers" is to identify, encourage and foster priestly vocations both for the Diocese and religious life, especially among the underprivileged and the poor. Owing to our charism and commitment, we recruit, educate, and care for the needs of our seminarians and priests free of charge. Our candidates are growing in number in most of our missions and the cost to educate and care for them is also increasing. We rely on the assistance of benefactors and fundraising, but help is urgently needed. The Vocationist Fathers, who work among those in need, currently serve God's people in 13 mission countries.

The Festival of Families is an international celebration of family, community, and faith. Everyone is invited to join in this joyful, global celebration of support and love. During this event, high-level performers, both music and visual, will entertain and educate participants from around the world.

The culmination of the Festival will be a nationally broadcast main stage program of music and spectacular visual arts performances by world renowned artists. Pope Francis will celebrate with us during this time, both to enjoy the show and to listen to six families from different continents briefly describe their joys and challenges. The Holy Father will respond with compassion and words of wisdom for all of us, speaking to those present at the event (more than a million) as well as the additional millions participating through remote viewing. In addition to the main stage, there will be a second stage and exhibits.
