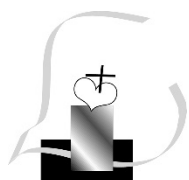
## ✠ Worship

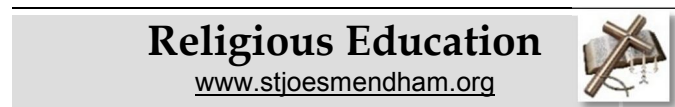
**Classes resume tomorrow** – students will have a 2 hour delayed opening. Thank you Student Council.

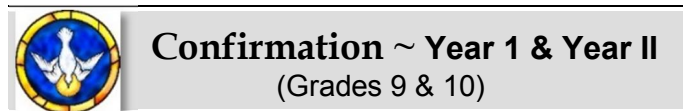
