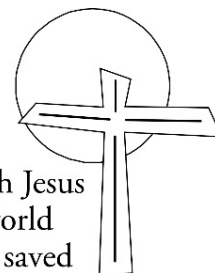

Next weekend, the **Feast of Corpus Christi**, our parish will participate in a Diocesan-wide food collection for the poor.
