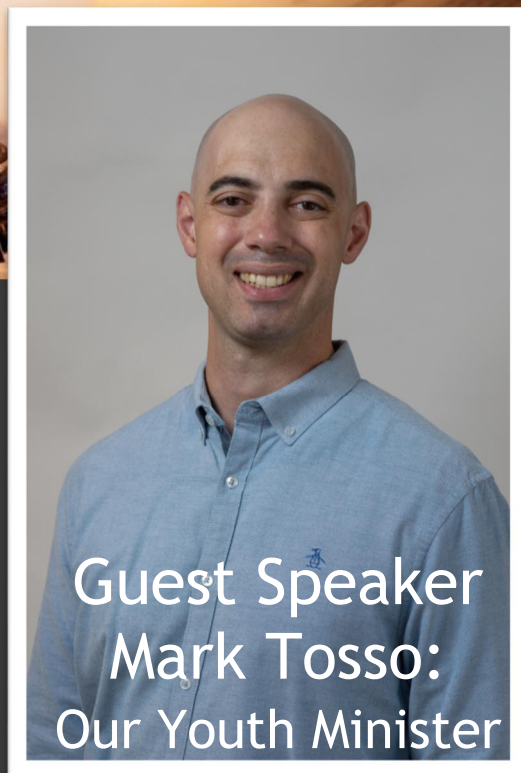

## **Bio of Mark Tosso**

Mark Tosso is Youth Minister at the Church of St. Joseph in Mendham. He earned a B.A. in History and a B.A. in Communication from the University of Maryland, an M.A. in Political Communication from Dublin City University in Ireland where he was a George J. Mitchell Scholar, and an M.A. in Theology from the College of St. Elizabeth in Convent Station. He is an Adjunct Professor at the College of St. Elizabeth, teaching courses in moral theology, ethics, and comparative religion. He serves on the Youth Ministry Advisory Board of the Diocese of Paterson.
