The Outreach Program serves the needs of people who are chronically and temporarily homeless, veterans, people who are exiting from jails and hospitals, youth, LGBTQ+, and people who are precariously housed. They provide the following: phone and computer access, a mailing address, restrooms, a warming / cooling center, information and referrals, a connection to medical, mental health and dental services, case management, systems advocacy, and more.
